## **Analytical Supervision – Group Clinics**

Clinical-Analytical Supervision – The Clinic is structured in several steps which follow the evolution of the case described by the analyst in the first part, in its development along the biological-biographical arrow of time of the life-story of the person. In this way the first three anamneses are evaluated:

- Analytical Approach,
- Remote Clinical Observation
- First-hand Clinical Observation

so identifying the eziopathogenetic variables, that is to say the incised marks, determining the phase fixations, the dominant bodily levels and the prevailing characterological traits including any pathologies beyond "threshold" level.

In this way a Clinical-Analytical Diagnosis is prepared which also underlines the Differential Diagnosis.

As the clinic progresses, the Transfert of energetic and psychodynamic states and the Transfert of trait-bodily level of the person as well as, significantly, the Countertransfert of energetic and psychodynamic states and the Countertransfert of trait-bodily level of the Analyst will all be clarified.

From the Overall View, the definition of the Stage of the Analytical Relationship and of the Group, psychodynamic and bodily trait Countertransfert follow.

On the basis of this information and these emotions the Targeted Clinical-Analytical Project is elaborated for the case negentropically and Vegetotherapy Actings suggest themselves to the Analyst for the specific case as does the "How" of the Relationship, again for that specific case.
